STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Resident Fishing Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 32, sub-§ II, amended. The 2nd paragraph of subsection II of section 32 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The clerks of all municipalities are authorized agents for the issuance of all fishing licenses. The commissioner may designate additional agents and shall determine the period during which they shall act. The license shall be issued upon payment of \$7.15 \$2,25, and the clerk shall retain \$150 250 from the fee. The license shall be valid for the calendar year in which it was issued. All licenses shall expire on midnight of December 31st of the year of issue. No license shall be wilfully issued to any person not a resident of the municipality in which said license is issued, and the penalty of any violation of this provision shall be \$10 and costs.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall become effective on January 1, 1948.
