STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Fees for Registered Guides.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 29, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 29 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'A fee of \$5 \$7 shall be paid annually for the registration of a Class A guide and a fee of \$4 \$6 shall be paid annually for a Class B guide. Non-residents may be so licensed upon payment of a fee of \$40 \$50. Persons licensed under this section may hunt and fish by virtue of their guide's license.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall become effective on January 1, 1948.
