RESOLVE, in Favor of Dr. S. S. Greenleaf, of Bethel.

Dr. S. S. Greenleaf; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$220 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Dr. S. S. Greenleaf, of Bethel, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred at 11.30 P. M. on July 11, 1945 in the town of Woodstock, and was investigated by game warden Alfred E. Jackson. Dr. Greenleaf's car was considerably damaged. The amount of damage is as follows: Right half of grill broken; plate underneath grill bent; head-light and right front fender completely smashed; trim on hood is broken and hood bent; radiator is sprung back toward motor; sprung right hand door; rear parking light and ventilating unit broken.
