RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Ralph Cooper, of Madison.

Mrs. Ralph Cooper; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$125 to be paid to Mrs. Ralph Cooper of Madison, as a full and final settlement for her claim against the state for jewelry stolen by a state ward; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Cooper boards several state wards and one of them, over a period of time, stole a ring, watch chain and locket.
