IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Woodpecker Farms, Inc., of Barnard Plantation.

Woodpecker Farms, Inc.; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$200 from the appropriation for the department of inland fisheries and game to be paid to Woodpecker Farms, Inc., of Barnard Plantation, as a full and final settlement for their claim against the state for damage to their yellow eye beans by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Three-quarters of an acre of yellow eye beans were destroyed by deer at the estimated amount of damage of \$200, and was reported to Game Warden C. C. Green.
