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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Willis P. Atwood of Auburn.**

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**Willis P. Atwood; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$138.50 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Willis P. Atwood of Auburn, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by deer.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Atwood's car was damaged considerably when it struck a deer on September 18, 1946, in So. Lewiston, and was investigated by Game Warden A. F. Piper. The damage is as follows: Radiator grill and ornament; headlight bracket; headlight lenses and rims; radiator core; radiator shell; both front fenders dented.
