RESOLVE, in Favor of Albert Walker of Rowes Corner, Auburn.

Albert Walker; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$144.42 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Albert Walker of Rowes Corner, Auburn, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on April 14, 1944 on the West Gray road in Gray, and was investigated by Game Warden A. F. Piper. The extent of the damage was: Right front mudguard, grill shell radiator, both headlights and bumper. The deer was taken by state police officer Young.
