RESOLVE, in Favor of Paul Caron of Auburn.

Paul Caron; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$114.10 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Paul Caron of Auburn, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On June 24, 1946, at 6 A. M., in the town of Farmington, Mr. Caron's car was damaged considerably when it struck a deer. Game Warden Edwin R. Pearson investigated the accident. The damage is as follows: Left headlight smashed; left mud guard badly dented; radiator grill broken; radiator pushed back so that fan cut core badly.
