**RESOLVE, in Favor of George P. Pulsifer, of Poland.**

**George P. Pulsifer; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$142 from the general fund of the state to be paid to George P. Pulsifer, of Poland, to reimburse him for burial expenses of Charles J. Small, a state pauper.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

In this case Charles J. Small, who was a mental patient, was committed to a mental institution in Massachusetts. Being committed to an institution in another state, it relieved the town of Casco, where he formerly resided, of any obligation to pay.
