RESOLVE, in Favor of Howard Fred Dupee, of Lewiston.

Fred Dupee; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$109.80 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Howard Fred Dupee, of Lewiston, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car caused by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On June 19, 1946, in Woodstock, Mr. Dupee's car struck a deer causing damage to his car to the extent of \$109.80. Damage is as follows: Windshield broken; vent window broken; front right door badly bent; handle broken; rear right door and frame bent, also hinge on rear right door bent. Game Warden Alfred E. Jackson investigated the accident.
