AN ACT Making It Lawful to Hunt on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 66, amended. Section 66 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'**Sec. 66. Sunday opened to hunting of birds and animals.** It shall be ~~unlawful~~ **lawful** to hunt on Sunday.'
