AN ACT Relating to the Board of Commissioners of Pharmacy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 62, § 1, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 1 of chapter 62 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'A board of commissioners of pharmacy, as heretofore established, shall consist of ~~3 suitable persons~~ **5 pharmacists all of whom shall be residents of the state and actually engaged in the practice of their profession**, who shall be appointed and may be removed for cause by the governor with the advice and consent of the council. The terms of office of said commissioners shall be so arranged that 1 member of said board shall be appointed annually ~~for a term of 3 years as the term of the present members expire,~~ **to hold office for 5 years** from the 1st day of December in each year or until his successor is appointed and qualified. Vacancies ~~caused by death, resignation, removal, or inability to perform the duties of the office~~ shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term. The board shall have power.'
