AN ACT Relating to Membership of Maine State Office Building Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. & S. L., 1941, c. 76, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 76 of the private and special laws of 1941 is hereby amended to read as follows :

'Sec. 4. Building commission authorized. There shall be a building commission of 5 members, one of which shall be the governor ~~who shall be chairman~~. The others shall be appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the council and may be removed at the pleasure of the governor and council. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments. **The members shall elect one of their number to be chairman.** Each of the members so appointed shall receive as compensation \$10 and actual and necessary expenses for each day during which he is actually engaged in the performance of his duties, to be paid out of any funds herein provided for, and upon vouchers approved by the governor and council.'
