IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Exempting from Taxation the Property of Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 81, § 6, sub-§ VIII, amended. Subsection VIII of section 6 of chapter 81 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'VIII. The polls ~~and estates~~ of Indians **and the property of Indians and tribes on reservations**; and the polls of persons under guardianship, or blind.'
