STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of a Bridge Across the West Branch of the Penobscot River, in Indian Purchase 3, Penobscot County.

Bridge over West Branch of Penobscot River; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$125,000 for the purpose of constructing a bridge across the West Branch of the Penobscot river in Penobscot county, on the state highway which leads from Brownville, in the county of Piscataquis, to Millinocket, in the county of Penobscot.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the present time there is no bridge over the West Branch of the Penobscot river and the present road from Brownville to Millinocket is 79 miles in length. This state highway was started in 1936 and since that time there has been expended thereon the sum of \$582,000. A bridge over the West Branch of the Penobscot river would decrease the mileage from Brownville to Millinocket to 32 miles, a saving of 47 miles.
