**RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Tote Road Pond in Moro Plantation
in Aroostook County.**

Taking of trout from Tote Road pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation making it illegal for any person or persons to take, catch, kill or have in their possession any trout taken from Tote Road pond, so called, in Moro Plantation, in the county of Aroostook, in any other way than by the ordinary manner of fly casting with artificial flies; and be it further

Resolved: That no person or persons shall take, catch, kill nor have in their possession more than 6 trout taken from the above waters by the ordinary method of fly casting, in any one day during the open season.
