STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Service of Writs in Western Somerset Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1901, c. 485, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 485 of the private and special laws of 1901 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 8. Writs and processes, form of. Writs and processes issued by said court shall be in the usual forms, and shall be served as like precepts are required to be served when issued by trial justices, except that writs in which the debt or damages demanded exceed \$20 shall be served at least 7 days before the sitting of the court at which they are made returnable, and no writ shall be made returnable at a term of the court to begin more than 60 65 days after the commencement of the action.'
