RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Somerset County to C. Max Hilton, of Greenville.

State tax assessor authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to C. Max Hilton, of Greenville, whatever interest the state has in 33/560 undivided of 21,890 acres in T. 4, R. 3, N. B. K. P. Somerset county and in 33/840 undivided of 21,890 acres in T. 4, R. 3, N. B. K. P. Somerset county. The 21890 acre tract is described as follows: All according to survey and plan of said township made and returned to the State Land Office by John Neal, et als in 1811-12. With exception of 2 farms containing 50 and 100 acres, exclusive of Public Lot, containing 21,890 acres, more or less. The sum due on these fractional interests is \$1,647.85.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The undivided fractional interest of $\frac{33}{560}$ of 21890 acres was sold November 27, 1934 for the 1932 taxes. The undivided fractional interest of $\frac{33}{840}$ of 21890 acres was sold November 25, 1942 for the 1940 taxes. C. Max Hilton, of Greenville, wishes to purchase this property for the sum of \$1,647.85 which is the amount of back taxes, interest and costs. This amount has been deposited with the treasurer of state.
