RESOLVE, Opening Peabody Pond in Naples, Sebago and Bridgton in the County of Cumberland to Ice Fishing for Pickerel.

Opening Peabody pond in Naples, Sebago and Bridgton to ice fishing for pickerel. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Peabody pond in Naples, Sebago and Bridgton in the county of Cumberland to ice fishing for pickerel from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring.
