RESOLVE, in Favor of Lawrence A. Niles of Kingfield.

Lawrence A. Niles; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$170.80 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Lawrence A. Niles, of Kingfield, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on November 1, 1946, around 10:30 P. M. in the town of Freeman, and was investigated by Game Warden, Earland S. Winter. Mr. Niles' car was damaged to the extent of: Grill destroyed, radiator destroyed, right fender destroyed, right head light destroyed and tire ruined.
