RESOLVE, in Favor of Josephine Heath, of Verona.

Josephine Heath; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$105 from the appropriation for the department of inland fisheries and game to be paid to Josephine Heath, of Verona, as a full and final settlement for her claim against the state for damage to her garden by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Heath who lives in an isolated location depends for her living largely on garden produce which she cares for and sells by her own efforts alone. Deer destroyed 2160 row feet of beans, 640 feet of carrots, 160 feet of peas and 90 feet of cabbage.
