RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Skowhegan.

Town of Skowhegan; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Skowhegan, the sum of \$125,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1948, and the sum of \$125,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1949, to aid in the repair and construction of highway route No. 201, beginning at the Fairfield-Skowhegan town line and extending northerly to Skowhegan village; said sum to be expended under the supervision of the state highway commission. Any unexpended balance at the end of any fiscal year shall not lapse but shall be carried forward for use in any succeeding fiscal year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This highway is part of the direct route to Quebec. It has deteriorated to a point that makes automobile travel dangerous.
