**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Hatchery Brook in the Town of
Belgrade, Kennebec County.**

Fishing in Hatchery brook, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Hatchery brook, from Salmon Lake to Great Pond, in the town of Belgrade, Kennebec county, to all fishing from the time the ice goes out in the spring to June 1.
