**AN ACT Relating to Commitment of Children to the Custody of Certain
Officers.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 136, §33, amended. Section 33 of chapter 136 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘, or the court or magistrate may, pending any adjournment of the case, order such child committed to the custody and control of any officer competent to serve criminal process to be by him safely kept and produced in court or before said magistrate at the time appointed.’
