STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Dissolve the Bay Point Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Bay Point Village Corporation, dissolved. The Bay Point Village Corporation created by chapter 11 of the private and special laws of 1925, is hereby dissolved, provided that any tax on property located within the limits of the corporation that may become due after April 1st, 1947 shall be collected by the town of Georgetown and shall become a part of the general tax funds of the town.

Sec. 2. Assets, disposal of. All real estate, personal property and any and all other moneys, funds or assets remaining in the hands of the officers of said Bay Point Village Corporation after the payment of all just debts against said corporation, shall be turned over, executed and delivered to the officers of a corporation to be organized for educational, moral and benevolent purposes for the benefit of the inhabitants of the town of Georgetown, said corporation to be located within the limits of the town of Georgetown.

Sec. 3. Corporation formed. The educational, moral and benevolent corporation above referred to shall be organized within 6 months from the effective date of this act and the remaining assets of the Bay Point Village Corporation referred to in section 2 of this act shall be delivered

to the officers of the educational, moral and benevolent corporation within said period of 6 months.
