Samuel Clark, Jr.; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$253.05 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Samuel Clark, Jr., of Oakland, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on October 4, 1945, in Sandy River Plantation, and was investigated by Game Warden Frank E. Phillips. The car, a Chrysler sedan, was damaged about the front end.
