STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Fort Fairfield.

Town of Fort Fairfield; interest charged off. Resolved: That the treasurer of state be, and hereby is, authorized to charge off the sum of \$2,468.01, interest on state taxes now charged against the town of Fort Fairfield for the years 1935 and 1936.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Fort Fairfield now owes the state \$2,468.01 as interest on state taxes. The town of Fort Fairfield was heavily in debt and had no money to pay. The entire principal of the taxes due to the state has been paid by the town.
