STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Richard Rollins, of Hebron.

Richard Rollins; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$147.35 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Richard Rollins, of Hebron, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on October 5, 1946, around 10:45 A. M., in Poland, and was investigated by Game Warden Stillman Johnson. Mr. Rollins' car, a Ford Tudor Sedan, was damaged to the following extent: Punched 4 holes in radiator; broken grill; bent right fender and right headlight; cannot start car without being pushed, cause unknown.
