RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Rights in Timber and Grass on Reserved Lands in Somerset County to C. Max Hilton of Greenville.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain rights. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is authorized to convey to C. Max Hilton, of Greenville, whatever rights in timber and grass the state has in an undivided 33/560 of 1,000 acres in 4, R. 3, N. B. K. P. Somerset county also an undivided 33/840 of 1,000 acres in 4, R. 3, N. B. K. P. Somerset county for the sum of \$43.06.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The undivided fractional interest of 33/560 of 1,000 acres reverted to the state for the 1932 taxes. The undivided 33/840 of 1,000 acres reverted to the state for the 1940 taxes. C. Max Hilton wishes to purchase this property for the sum of \$43.06 which is the amount of taxes and interest plus \$1 for deed. This amount has been deposited with the treasurer of state.
