RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Rights in Timber and Grass on Reserved Lands in Penobscot County to Stanley J. Hinch, of Danforth.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain rights. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is authorized to convey to Stanley J. Hinch, of Danforth, whatever rights in timber and grass the state has in an undivided $\frac{1}{6}$ of 960 acres in T. 7, R. 7, W. E. L. S. Penobscot county, for the sum of \$66.33.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The undivided fractional interest of $\frac{1}{6}$ of 960 acres reverted to the state for the 1941 taxes. Stanley J. Hinch wishes to purchase this property for the sum of \$66.33 which is the amount of taxes and interest plus \$1 for deed. This amount has been deposited with the treasurer of state.
