STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Islands in Penobscot County to Alice E. Ward, of Hampden Highlands.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain islands. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Alice E. Ward, of Hampden Highlands, whatever interest the state has in a small island near a sand bar, also another island, both in Eskutassis Pond, in Lowell, containing one acre, more or less.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

No one apparently claims title to these islands and title is supposedly in the State of Maine.
