### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in favor of L. Archer Weymouth of Clinton.

L. Archer Weymouth; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,640.85 to be paid to L. Archer Weymouth, of Clinton to compensate him in full for loss of buildings and contents by fire kindled by Nelson Hendrickson and John Hobbs, state wards, said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state wards named, Nelson Hendrickson, about 7 years of age, and John Hobbs, about 8 years of age, were being boarded by claimant. On July 22, 1945, fire started in the hay of the barn which destroyed the barn, contents and hen house. The boys admitted to setting the fire.

The barn was 42' x 32' x 16', single boarded and planked with 2" planks, sides shingled, one side of roof shingled and other side covered with roofing, contains 6 windows, 3 doors, valued at \$1500.
