RESOLVE, in Favor of the Augusta General Hospital.

Augusta General Hospital; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$144.45 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the Augusta General Hospital, of Augusta, to reimburse said hospital for hospitalization and medical aid extended to Leslie D. Butler; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

Statement of Facts

Mr. Butler was brought to the hospital in emergency condition on August 30, 1945, and his case was attended as demanding immediate service. Through oversight no application was made to the state for aid. He is a native of the town of Appleton and is receiving aid from that settlement.
