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AN ACT Relating to Bounty on Bears.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 33, § 103, amended.** The 1st paragraph of section 103 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'A bounty of \$10 shall be paid for each and every bear killed in organized townships and plantations to the person killing the same by the treasurer of the organized township or plantation in which said bear was killed, **except that a bounty of \$25 shall be paid for each and every bear killed in B, C, and D townships and in the towns of Monticello, Littleton and Bridgewater in the county of Aroostook.** These bounties shall be paid by the treasurers of said towns or plantations.'
