RESOLVE, in Favor of Charles A. Dean Memorial Hospital for Services
Rendered to James Smith, a State Pauper.

Charles A. Dean Memorial Hospital; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$246.20 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the Charles A. Dean Memorial Hospital, to reimburse said hospital for services rendered to James Smith, state pauper; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Smith was admitted to the hospital with serious burns and seemingly disoriented. A special attendant had to be assigned to his case. On the 2nd of July 1944, this man cut his throat in attempted suicide and this prolonged his hospital stay, also necessitated employing extra help to watch over him. It was necessary to use extensively of stock ointments and dressings. The Hospital is asking for reimbursement in the sum of \$246.20.
