**RESOLVE, Opening Pleasant Lake, in Washington County, to Ice
Fishing.**

Pleasant lake; opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Pleasant lake, T. 6, R. 1 - T. 7, R. 2, Washington county, to ice fishing for all fish, except bass, during February on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays, only.
