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**AN ACT Relating to Contract Carriers.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 44, § 21, amended.** The 2nd sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 21 of chapter 44 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Whether or not any person, firm or corporation is engaging regularly in the transportation business within the meaning of this paragraph shall be a question of fact, to be determined by the commission, the supreme judicial court, the superior court or a municipal court ~~but the making of more than 2 trips for hire during any 30 day period shall be deemed as regularly engaging in the transportation business.~~
