STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Payment of Fines and Costs and the Salary of the Judge of the Municipal Court in the Town of East Livermore, now Livermore Falls.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1899, c. 120, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 120 of the private and special laws of 1899, as amended by chapter 73 of the private and special laws of 1915, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 13. Payment of fines and costs; salary of judge. All fees, civil and criminal, shall inure to the county of Androscoggin and shall be paid over to the treasurer of said county by said judge on the first day of each month in accordance with the provisions of section 5 of chapter 137 of the revised statutes of 1944 and amendments thereto. The judge of said court shall receive an annual salary of six hundred dollars \$1,200 in full for all services, payable quarterly, on the first days of April, July, October and January weekly from the treasury of Androscoggin county.'
