STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the City of Augusta.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1919, c. 75, § 13, amended. The 1st sentence of section 13 of chapter 75 of the private and special laws of 1919 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The compensation of the judge in full for all services, commencing April first, nineteen hundred and nine January 1, 1947, shall be eighteen hundred dollars \$2,800 per annum, payable quarterly monthly from the treasury of the eity of Augusta county of Kennebec.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1919, c. 75, § 16, amended. The 1st sentence of section 16 of chapter 75 of the private and special laws of 1919 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All fees for criminal cases shall be allowed and taxed as in behalf of trial justices and shall together with the fees paid in by said judge to the county treasury be annually paid to the city of Augusta county of Kennebec; provided, however, that if the amount of such fees so allowed and the fees paid in by said judge during the year shall exceed the amount of his annual salary, such excess shall revert to the county and be covered into the county treasury.'
