**RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey the State's
Interest in Certain Lands.**

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved:
That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, empowered and directed to convey to Leighton Castle the state's interest in and to a parcel of land, partly in the town of Belgrade and partly in the town of Rome, as bounded and described in Kennebec registry of deeds, book 678, page 395, the same being the same premises conveyed by the town of Belgrade to Leighton Castle aforesaid.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1931 the town of Belgrade conveyed to Leighton Castle, of Belgrade, this island, and Mr. Castle has spent a good deal of money and effort in developing a summer resort on the island. He now finds that the title is in the state and this resolve is to cure such title.
