STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Maine State Park Commission to Convey a Lot of Land Situated in Bangor, to William Carmalt, of Bangor.

William Carmalt; conveyance of land. Resolved: That the Maine state park commission be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to William Carmalt, of Bangor, whatever interest the state has in the following described lot of land situated in Bangor in the county of Penobscot: The lot of land known as the old Arsenal Lot which was conveyed to the state of Maine by Asa Davis, of Bangor, on November 13, 1838, recorded in Vol. 103, Page 266, Penobscot registry of deeds, and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning on the westerly side of Essex street, near Samuel Eastman's dwelling house and 187 feet and 8 inches northerly of the angle in said street; then running north 87° west at right angles with said street 24 rods to a stake; then southerly at right angles with the above mentioned line 14 rods to a stake; then south 87° east and parallel with the first mentioned line about $23\frac{3}{4}$ rods to said Essex street; then northerly on the line of said Essex street about 14 rods to the place of beginning;

for the sum of \$420.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This lot is now vacant and grown up with weeds and is outside of the compact and built-up section of Bangor on the Pushaw road; and the park commission is of the opinion that this lot cannot be utilized by the commission for park purposes. The present offer by Mr. Carmalt is for the original purchase price.
