AN ACT Amending the Charter of the Town of Rumford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1935, c. 48, § 1, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 48 of the private and special laws of 1935 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘All meetings of the town, both regular and special, shall be notified by the person to whom the warrant is directed by posting attested copies of said warrant, one in the municipal building and one in the post office at Rumford Center, 7 days at least before the day of such meeting, and by causing an attested copy to be published twice in some newspaper published in Rumford, if any there be, the first publication to be 7 days at least before the day of such meeting. The hour of meeting shall be fixed by the board of selectmen.’

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1935, c. 48, § 3, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 3 of chapter 48 of the private and special laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Regular meetings of the board of selectmen shall be held at the selectmen’s office on ~~the 1st and 3rd Wednesday~~ every other Thursday evening

of each month. Regular meetings of the superintending school committee shall be held in the superintendent's office on the evening of the 2nd Tuesday of each month.'
