AN ACT Relating to Unredeemed Tickets on Pari Mutuel Pools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 77, § 16, amended. Section 16 of chapter 77 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:

'At the close of every race meet at which pari mutuel wagering has been permitted, the commission shall be furnished by the person, corporation or association licensed to conduct such meet, with a complete list of all pari mutuel tickets not redeemed. The monetary value of these tickets shall be deposited with the treasurer of state. At the close of each fiscal year, the value of all unredeemed tickets for the preceding calendar year's race meets shall lapse to the general fund of the state.'
