RESOLVE, in Favor of Boyd A. Blaisdell, of Ellsworth.

Boyd A. Blaisdell; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$152.80 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Boyd A. Blaisdell, of Ellsworth, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on October 26, 1945, in Hancock, and was investigated by Game Warden George S. Bradbury. The car, a Pontiac sedan, was damaged about the front end.
