RESOLVE, in Favor of Edwin Sprague, of Ellsworth.

Edwin Sprague; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$27.90 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Edwin Sprague, of Ellsworth, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred in Trenton, on April 15, 1946, and was investigated by Game Warden Robert Hogan. The car, a Chevrolet coupe, was damaged at the front and right side.
