RESOLVE, in Favor of T. P. Walker, of Bluehill.

T. P. Walker; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$178.85 from the general fund of the state to be paid to T. P. Walker, of Bluehill, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on October 5, 1946, in Bluehill, and was investigated by Game Warden H. E. Sinclair, Jr. The car, a Ford Station Wagon, was damaged about the left side and front.
