# STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

### **RESOLVE**, in Favor of Arthur F. Bowie of Auburn.

Arthur F. Bowie; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$109.90 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Arthur F. Bowie, of Auburn, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his automobile caused by a deer.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

On November 20, 1944, Arthur F. Bowie was operating his 1937 Pontiac sedan on the Pownal or New Gloucester Road, in Durham, Maine, at about 5 o'clock in the morning. A deer jumped from the bushes at the side of the road directly in front of the automobile, breaking the hood, grille and lights and fenders. Actual repair bill was \$109.90, paid by Mr. Bowie.
