**RESOLVE, Permitting Fly Fishing, in Certain Waters of Franklin
County.**

Permitting fly fishing, in certain waters of Franklin county. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting fly fishing only with the daily bag limit of 6 trout, salmon or togue of not more than 5 pounds total weight. Prohibiting the taking of trout less than 8 inches in length and establishing the daily bag limit as the possession limit on the following waters:

Dead river (North Branch, Eustis dam to Chain of Ponds dam) and tributaries.

Round Mt. lake (Alder Stream Twp.).

Stratton brook ponds and tributaries.

Stratton brook above dam in Stratton village and tributaries.

Arnold pond.

Beaver pond—Seven Ponds Twp.

Big Island pond.

Blanchard pond (Alder Stream Twp.)

Chain of Ponds.
Crosby pond.
Ell pond.
Grant pond.
Horseshoe pond.
Little Island pond.
Little Jim pond.
Little Northwest pond.
Long pond (Seven Ponds Twp.)
Mud pond (Coburn Gore).
Massachusetts bog.
