**RESOLVE, Opening the South Branch of Dead River and Tributaries  
(Except Nash Stream) to both Fly and Bait Fishing.**

---

**Opening the south branch of Dead river and tributaries (except Nash stream) to both fly and bait fishing. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the south branch of Dead river and tributaries (except Nash stream) to both fly and bait fishing with the daily limit of 10 fish per person per day, establishing a minimum length for trout at 8 inches and for salmon at 14 inches.
