RESOLVE, Opening Big Magalloway River in Oxford County from the Big Eddy to the Outlet of Rump Pond to Fly Fishing.

Opening Big Magalloway river in Oxford county from the Big Eddy to the outlet of Rump pond to fly fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Big Magalloway river in the county of Oxford from the Big Eddy to the outlet of Rump pond to fly fishing only from September 15 to October 1, with the limit of 1 fish per person.
